

## Field etiquette and Terms and Conditions

Every user must have agreed to our terms and conditions prior to booking.

### **We do not allow:**

- dog walkers
- borders
- daycare
- trainers
- behaviourists

or other professionals to use our field in a professional capacity without receiving consent prior to booking.

- A maximum of three cars is permitted per booking and they must be parked inside the field in the parking area.
- A maximum of six dogs per booking is permitted.
- All users must ensure their dog is vaccinated before visiting our field and ensure they are regularly tested for worms fleas ETC.
- A dog who has been unwell in the 48 hours before booking must not attend.
- Bookings commence on the hour and are 50 minutes long. There is a 10 minute changeover in between bookings, and you must be in your car exiting the gate at the 50 minute mark to ensure you have vacated the site before the next user arrives.
- If you arrive early for your booking please wait in the shop car park.
- Do not enter the field before your booking start time even if it appears empty.
- You must secure unlock the gate behind you at the end of your session and ensure the padlock code is scrambled.
- Dogs and children must be supervised at all times.
- All poo must be picked up and disposed of with no exceptions. The bins provided are for poo bags, and you must take any other rubbish home with you.
- When using the field and any equipment you do so at your own risk.
- We do not allow the use of ball throwing machines.

- We do not permit the use of aversive training methods equipment or behaviours.
- You must not share the access codes with anyone.
- Kings Farm Dog Park (also known as Kings Farm Shop) cannot be held responsible or accept liability for any illnesses or impairments dogs may pick up whilst at the dog park. This includes but is not limited to, any injuries sustained whilst using the park, any illnesses that become apparent whilst at the dog park or after using the dog park, or any substances your dog may ingest whilst at the dog park.
- Due to the recent law updates regarding banned breeds including excel bullies we regret to inform you that we will not be able to accept any banned breeds into the dog park.

**Anyone not adhering to the rules of the dog park will be banned from future bookings and may be removed from site before your booking end time.**
